

SALARY BOARD MINUTES

October 24, 2017

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called immediately following the Commissioners regular meeting at 10:16 a.m.

ROLL CALL OF MEMBERS:

Present: Commissioner Josh Lang, Commissioner Barry L. Dallara, Commissioner S. Paul Crooks and Melissa Cottle, Treasurer. Others present: Debra Brown, Chief Clerk/Director of Elections, Terry Stacey, CDBG Administrator, David Cubbison, Director of Emergency Services, Lisa Cairo, Director of Bedford County Children and Youth Services, Susan Ross, Fiscal Technician at Bedford County Children and Youth Services, county residents and the press.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The minutes of October 10, 2017, were approved as presented.

OLD BUSINESS:

There was no old business to present.

NEW BUSINESS:

A motion was made by Melissa Cottle, Treasurer and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to approve the rate of \$8.17 per hour for Brittany Prime the Clerk Typist I in the office of H. Cyril Bingham, Jr., Magisterial District No. 57-3-02, effective October 25, 2017. This is based upon the recommendation of President Judge Thomas S. Ling. The motion was approved as presented.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dallara and seconded by Commissioner Crooks to approve the salary increase for Susan Ross, Fiscal Technician to \$12.13 per hour, effective October 23, 2017. This is based upon the recommendation of Lisa Cairo, Administrator of Bedford County Children and Youth Services. The motion shows as one opposed and two approved. The question was asked as to why the opposition and Melissa Cottle's response was as follow: "In my opinion, it's not the hiring; she is already here as an employee. It's to give an increase and to promote her to a fiscal tech. My opinion they already have two fiscal techs in that one department and I feel two is sufficient, and again she is a fiscal assistant. Again, that is my opinion and that is why I voted against it."

A motion was made by Commissioner Crooks and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to approve the following employee wages at \$11.00 per hour, per union contract, as part-time Correctional Officers at the Bedford Correctional Facility. This is based upon the recommendation of Troy Nelson, Warden at the Bedford County Correctional Facility.

The motion was approved as presented.

A motion was made by Melissa Cottle, Treasurer and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to approve an increase of \$.05 per hour, per union contract for James Baker, Correctional Officer at the Bedford County Correctional Facility, effective October 16, 2017. The increase is due to the longevity clause. The motion was approved as presented.
