

SALARY BOARD MEETING MINUTES

September 24, 2019

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called immediately following the Commissioners regular meeting at 10:23 a.m.

ROLL CALL OF MEMBERS:

Present: Commissioner Josh Lang, Commissioner Barry L. Dallara, Commissioner S. Paul Crooks, and Melissa Cottle, Treasurer. Others present: Debra Brown, Chief Clerk/Director of Elections; Don Schwartz, Director, Planning Commission; Terry Stacey, CDBG Administrator; Matthew Godissart, Director Bedford County Library and Lisa Cairo, Administrator of Bedford County Children and Youth Services, county residents, and the press.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The minutes of September 10, 2019 meeting were approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

There was nothing to report

NEW BUSINESS:

A motion was made by Melissa Cottle and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to approve the wage of \$11.30 per hour, per union contract for Katie Musselman, Fishertown, PA a Full-time Correctional Officer, effective October 1, 2019. This is based upon the recommendation of Troy Nelson, Warden at the Bedford County Correctional Facility. The motion was approved as presented.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dallara and seconded by Commissioner Crooks to approve the wage of \$11.30 per hour, per union contract for Thomas Langley, South Fork, PA a Part-time Correctional Officer, effective September 25, 2019. This is based upon the recommendation of Troy Nelson, Warden at the Bedford County Correctional Facility. The motion was approved as presented.

A motion was made by Commissioner Crooks and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to approve the wage of \$11.80 per hour, per union contract for Justin Silvis, South Fork, PA a Part-time Correctional Officer, effective September 25, 2019. This is based upon the recommendation of Troy Nelson, Warden at the Bedford County Correctional Facility. The motion was approved as presented.

A question was asked how long it would be before the new hires would be harassed by the senior officers; Commissioner Lang said he would not respond to that question.

Another question was asked about the wages; Commissioner Lang stated this is set by the unions.

A motion was made by Melissa Cottle and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to approve an increase of \$.50 per hour, per union contract for Anthony Miller, Correctional Officer, effective October 1, 2019, for completing one year of service. The motion was approved as presented.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dallara and seconded by Commissioner Crooks to approve an increase of \$.25 per hour, per union contract for Theresa Price, Correctional Officer, effective October 3, 2019, for longevity. The motion was approved as presented.

COMMENTS/APPOINTMENTS:

Lisa Cairo asked about the wage difference; Commissioner Lang responded to her question.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dallara and seconded by Commissioner Crooks to adjourn the meeting at 10:27 a.m.
