CALL TO ORDER:

This is based upon the recommendation of Charwin Reichelderfer, Sheriff. The motion was approved as presented.

A motion was made by Melissa Cottle, Treasurer and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to approve an \$.25 increase per hour, per union contract for longevity for Cassandra Eshelman, Corrections Officer, effective January 18, 2019. The motion was approved as presented.
