NEW BUSINESS:

A motion was made by Melissa Cottle and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to approve the salary of \$11.30 per hour per union contract for Richard Kidd, of Saxton, PA as full-time Correctional Officer at the Bedford County Correctional Facility, effective November 13, 2019. This based on the recommendation of Troy Nelson, Warden. The motion was approved as presented.

This is a replacement hire and funding will come from the 9-1-1 surcharge funds. This is based on the recommendation of David E. Cubbison, Director, Bedford County Department of Emergency Services.
