

BEDFORD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WEEKLY MEETING

February 02, 2016

The Bedford County Board of Commissioners held their regular meeting in Room 101 of the Bedford County Government Building, 200 S. Juliana Street, Bedford, PA on Tuesday, February 02, 2016. Commissioner Josh Lang called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM and Commissioner S. Paul Crooks gave the prayer of invocation and led the pledge to the flag.

Commissioner Josh Lang, Commissioner Barry L. Dallara and Commissioner S. Paul Crooks were present.
