

BEDFORD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WEEKLY MEETING

February 23, 2016

The Bedford County Board of Commissioners held their regular meeting in Room 101 of the Bedford County Government Building, 200 S. Juliana Street, Bedford, PA on Tuesday, February 23, 2016. Commissioner Josh Lang called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM and Commissioner S. Paul Crooks gave the prayer of invocation and led the pledge to the flag.

Commissioner Josh Lang, Commissioner Barry L. Dallara and Commissioner S. Paul Crooks were present. Others present were Jill Gordon, Chief Clerk/Director of Elections; Melissa Cottle, Treasurer; Donald Schwartz, Planning Commission Director; Bob Bittner, Snyders Gateway Inc.; and members of the public and press.

The Minutes of February 16, 2016 were approved as presented.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dallara and seconded by Commissioner Crooks to approve the following expenditures:

A motion was made by Commissioner Dallara and seconded by Commissioner Crooks to approve the following Purchase of Service Agreements, each for a term of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016, between Bedford County Children and Youth Services and Bedford County Juvenile Probation Office and:

1. George Junior Republic in PA, and
2. Appalachian Youth Service, and
3. Youth Educational Services of PA.

The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Crooks and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to approve Eric Neatrour of New Paris, PA to the Board of Directors at Old Bedford Village. This is based on the recommendation of the Board of Directors of Old Bedford Village. The motion passed unanimously.

There was no further business to discuss.

Commissioner Dallara read a letter of appreciation and thanks addressed to the Bittner Family of Snyders Gateway Inc. for the \$10,000.00 donation for use toward the Pike2Bike Master Plan update. Commissioner Lang made presentation of the letter to Bob Bittner. A member from the floor asked of Mr. Bittner whether a similar donation had been made to Fulton County to which Mr. Bittner relayed that a \$5,000.00 donation had been given in December of 2014. Commissioner Dallara went on to speak of economic development in reference to Pike2Bike.

A motion was made by Commissioner Crooks and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to adjourn the Commissioners' Meeting at 10:08 AM.
