

SALARY BOARD MEETING

January 05, 2016

The Bedford County Salary Board met immediately following the Commissioners Board Meeting on Tuesday, January 05, 2016. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Josh Lang at 10:15 A.M. Members present were Commissioner Josh Lang, Commissioner Barry L. Dallara, Commissioner S. Paul Crooks, and Treasurer Melissa A. Cottle. Others present were Jill Gordon, Chief Clerk/Director of Elections; Don Schwartz, Planning Commission; Cathy Fetter, Prothonotary; David Cubbison, Emergency Services Director; Pam Corley, Emergency Service Coordinator; Harry Corley, Emergency Services Coordinator; Tammie Hess, Representative Jesse Topper's Office; Jim Gonsman, First National Bank; and members of the public and press.

The minutes of the December 29, 2015 meeting were approved as presented.

There was no old business to discuss.

A motion was made by Treasurer Cottle and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to set the annual salary of Shirley Deremer, Deputy Treasurer with the Bedford County Treasurer's Office, at \$20,500.00 effective January 4, 2016. This is based on the recommendation of Melissa Cottle, Treasurer. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dallara and seconded by Commissioner Crooks to set the hourly rate of Joshua Gregor, Full-time Telecommunicator with the Bedford County Department of Emergency Services at \$11.56 per hour to be paid from the 9-1-1 surcharge funds, effective January 18, 2016. This is based on the recommendation of David Cubbison, Director. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Crooks and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to approve the beginning 2016 employee wage and salary schedule effective January 1, 2016.

Highlights:

- Corrections Officers—2%, per contract
- Court Appointed—2% , per contract
- Court Appointed Probation Officers--\$ 500.00, per contract
- Court Related--\$0.30/hour, per contract

The motion passed unanimously.

A question was raised by Cathy Fetter, Prothonotary regarding how the salary decision was reached for the Deputy Treasurer position. She expressed some concern giving the example of a First Deputy with longevity who only makes \$22,000.00. The question was briefly addressed that the salary had been discussed between the Treasurer and Finance Director and that the matter could be discussed following the meeting.

There was no further business to discuss.

Commissioner Dallara moved to adjourn Salary Board was seconded by Commissioner Crooks. Salary Board adjourned at 10:17 A.M.
