

## **SALARY BOARD MEETING**

March 08, 2016

The Bedford County Salary Board met immediately following the Commissioners Board Meeting on Tuesday, March 08, 2016. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Josh Lang at 10:16 A.M. Members present were Commissioner Josh Lang, Commissioner S. Paul Crooks, and Treasurer Melissa A. Cottle. Member absent was Commissioner Barry L. Dallara. Others present were Jill Gordon, Chief Clerk/Director of Elections; Donald Schwartz, Planning Commission Director; Lisa Cairo, Children and Youth Services; David Cubbison, Emergency Services Director; Lloyd Roach, Amateur Radio Society and fellow club members; and members of the public and press.

The minutes of the February 16, 2016 meeting were approved as presented.

There was no old business to discuss.

A motion was made by Treasurer Cottle and seconded by Commissioner Crooks to set the hourly rate of following Telecommunicator Trainees with the Bedford County Department of Emergency Services at \$10.34 per hour to be paid from the 9-1-1 surcharge funds effective March 28, 2016 and is based on the recommendation of David Cubbison, Director:

1. Cassie J. Waybright; and
2. Cathy Colledge.

The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Crooks and seconded by Treasurer Cottle to set the annual salary of Ashley Black and Robert Walls, II; Caseworker II with Bedford County Children and Youth Services, at \$24,726.15 effective March 15, 2016; based on the recommendation of Lisa Cairo, Administrator. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Treasurer Cottle and seconded by Commissioner Crooks to set the annual salary of Clarissa Hartman, Program Specialist with Bedford County Children and Youth Services, at \$30,538.17 effective March 28, 2016 and based on the recommendation of Lisa Cairo, Administrator. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Crooks and seconded by Treasurer Cottle to approve a \$0.10 per hour increase for James Baker, Corrections Officer at the Bedford County Correctional Facility, per union contract for longevity, effective March 23, 2016. The motion passed unanimously.

There was no further business to discuss.

Commissioner Crooks moved to adjourn Salary Board and was seconded by Treasurer Cottle. Salary Board adjourned at 10:20 A.M.
