

**SALARY BOARD MEETING**

May 24, 2016

The Bedford County Salary Board met immediately following the Commissioners Board Meeting on Tuesday, May 24, 2016. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Josh Lang at 10:32 A.M. Members present were Commissioner Josh Lang, Commissioner Barry L. Dallara, Commissioner S. Paul Crooks, and Treasurer Melissa A. Cottle. Others present were Jill Gordon, Chief Clerk/Director of Elections; Troy Nelson, Warden; Don Schwartz, Planning Commission Director; Robert Haffner, Schneider Electric; William Turner, Coast Guard Auxiliary; Bette Slayton, Bedford County Development Association; and members of the public and press.

The minutes of the May 10, 2016 meeting were approved as presented.

There was no old business to discuss.

A motion was made by Treasurer Cottle and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to approve a \$0.10 per hour increase for Michael Stacey, Corrections Officer with the Bedford County Correctional Facility, per union contract longevity clause, effective June 1, 2016. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commission Dallara and seconded by Commissioner Crooks to set the annual salary of the Julie Kidd and Jennifer Ray, Caseworker I with Bedford County Children and Youth Services, at \$22,668.00 per year effective May 31, 2016, based on the recommendation of Lisa Cairo, Administrator. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Crooks and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to set the hourly rate of Lucille Kentner, Treatment Specialist at the Bedford County Correctional Facility, at \$13.00 per hour effective June 8, 2016; and is based on the recommendation of Troy Nelson, Warden. The motion passed unanimously.

There was no further business to discuss.

Commissioner Crooks moved to adjourn Salary Board and was seconded by Commissioner Dallara. Salary Board adjourned at 10:35 A.M.
