

SALARY BOARD MEETING

July 5, 2016

The Bedford County Salary Board met immediately following the Commissioners Board Meeting on Tuesday, July 5, 2016. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Josh Lang at 10:30 A.M. Members present were Commissioner Josh Lang, Commissioner Barry L. Dallara, Commissioner S. Paul Crooks, and Treasurer Melissa A. Cottle. Others present were Andrea Ferguson, Administrative Assistant to Jill Gordon, Chief Clerk/Director of Elections; Lisa Cairo, Children & Youth Services Director, Don Schwartz, Planning Commission Director; Rick Suter, Planning Commission; Joseph Saxfield, II, Planning Commission; Diane Nelson, Sheriff's Office; Dave Cubbison, Emergency Management Director; and members of the public and press.

The minutes of the June 21, 2016 meeting were approved as presented.

There was no old business to discuss.

A motion was made by Treasurer Cottle and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to set the hourly rate of Debra Brown, Chief Clerk, at \$14.00 per hour effective July 11, 2016; this is based on the recommendation of the Bedford County Board of Commissioners. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dallara and seconded by Commissioner Crooks to set the hourly rate of Nicole A. Deffibaugh, Clerk Typist I with the Bedford County Domestic Relations Office, at \$8.17 per hour effective July 6, 2016; this is based on the recommendation of the Honorable Thomas S. Ling dated June 30, 2016. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Crooks and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to approve at \$0.10 per hour increase, per union contract longevity clause, for Corrections Officer, Matthew Rothhaar, effective July 6, 2016. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Treasurer Cottle and seconded by Commissioner Crooks to approve a \$0.05 per hour increase, per union contract longevity clause, for Magisterial District Justice employee, Melinda Neville-Eicher, effective July 9, 2016. The motion passed unanimously.

There was no further business to discuss.

Commissioner Crooks moved to adjourn Salary Board and was seconded by Commissioner Dallara. Salary Board adjourned at 10:32 A.M.
