

SALARY BOARD MEETING

July 19, 2016

The Bedford County Salary Board met immediately following the Commissioners Board Meeting on Tuesday, July 19, 2016. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Josh Lang at 10:19 A.M. Members present were Commissioner Josh Lang, Commissioner Barry L. Dallara, Commissioner S. Paul Crooks, and Treasurer Melissa A. Cottle. Others present were Debra Brown, Chief Clerk, Andrea Ferguson, Administrative Assistant to Debra Brown, Chief Clerk, Terry Stacey, Planning Commission, Diane Nelson, Deputy Sheriff and members of the public and press.

The minutes of the July 5, 2016 meeting were approved as presented.

There was no old business to discuss.

A motion was made by Treasurer Cottle and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to set the salary of Michael Clapper, Administrator for Finance and Support Services, at an annual salary of \$55,000.00 effective August 1, 2016. This is based on the recommendation of the Bedford County Board of Commissioners. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dallara and seconded by Commissioner Crooks to approve the hourly rate of Cheryl May, Clerk 1 with the Bedford County Sheriff's Office, at \$9.08 per hour, per union contract, effective July 25, 2016, and is based on the recommendation of Sheriff Reichelderfer. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Crooks and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to set the hourly rate of Heather Mills, Deputy Sheriff with the Bedford County Sheriff's Office, at \$10.70 per hour, per union contract, effective July 25, 2016, and is based on the recommendation of Sheriff Reichelderfer. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Treasurer Cottle and seconded by Commissioner Dallara to increase the hourly rate of \$.07 increase per hour increase, per union contract under the longevity clause, for Sheriff's Deputy, Joseph Foor, effective, 8/1/2016. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dallara and seconded by Commissioner Crooks to approve the hourly rate of Anita D. Goodwin at \$12.13 per hour effective August 1, 2016, by court order of President Judge Thomas S. Ling. The motion passed unanimously.

A member of the public asked about the proposed 2nd amendment resolution at the July 5, 2016 meeting. Commissioner Lang stated that they are still reviewing the resolution and acquiring feedback from the community. Some additional discussion followed.

Commissioner Dallara moved to adjourn Salary Board and was seconded by Commissioner Crooks. Salary Board adjourned at 10:25 A.M.
